Dear Parents and Students:

Happy New Year and welcome back. I hope that all of you had a wonderful Holiday. We spent some of our vacation work on some new renovation at the studio. I hope that you will all enjoy the new floor that was put down by Lisa Carlson and Quality Maintenance Contractors.

It's now January and time to think about Spring Recital. This year our recital will be held Thursday and Saturday, June 10 & 12, at the Greenville High School Auditorium. All students must attend Dress Rehearsal on Thursday to perform in the recital. This week we will begin to measure the students for their costumes. I always measure "bigger" than what the students actually are so that when they grow between now and the show the costumes will still fit them. All costumes are **specialy made to order and can not be canceled or returned.** Along with your lesson fees, a \$30.00 deposit is due, the first week of this month, per costume that your child will be wearing. The balance is due of the week of **January 11, 2010**. They need one main costume per one hour class that they take. The total amount due per class for this costume is \$84.80 including tax (\$80+\$4.80). If they are in any class older than Pre-school level they will be participating in the group opening number and they will be wearing a simple printed t-shirt and glove costume along with a pair of black dance pants (that most of you already have). There is an additional cost of \$13.78, including tax, for this costume. Paying the deposit constitutes that you are giving permission for Miss Dee's School of Dance to order your child's costume and promises payment of the Balance by the week of Jan. 11, 2010. Costumes are non-refundable and non-cancelable. The reason that we have to order so early is that it takes between 10 - 15 weeks for the costumes to be made and shipped to us. Costumes come mostly assembled and ready to wear. Recital is a wonderful experience and your child will love their moment under the bright lights in their bright sparkly costume.

The weather is now getting colder and that means that the studio will be cooler. Please remember that I DO NOT ALLOW the students to wear baggy clothing over their leotards. They may wear a snug fitting dance jacket, sweater or shrug, leg warmers or a fitting turtle neck under their leotard. The rule I use is that any clothing may not be any looser than 1 inch away from the body. Any child who wears clothing looser than one inch will be given a loaner leotard to wear for the day or will not be able to participate in class. All students must wear dance attire to class. If you have questions as to what type of clothing this is, you can refer to the dress code flyer that you received in your packet at the beginning of the year or ask Miss Dee. The only exception to this rule is if Miss Dee has posted an extreme cold weather notice. In this case students may wear sweats. This means on days when the temperature outside is extremely bring sweats with you. With more cold and snow on the way please remember that if weather is bad and we will not be having classes you will receive an email (if you are on the email update list) or it will be listed on WOOD TV Channel 8. If you are in doubt if there is class please call the studio.

This month's Students of the Month are Lilly Workman and Emma Kosinski. Both of these students are great students who are really excited about dance classes.

There has been some difficulty with the Holiday recital video and have not been able to post it to the website due to a disk error. We are trying to recover the data and hope to have it up soon. I'm looking forward to another great year. See you in class.
